At the end of the program, participants will understand the benefits of rubber flooring in building and the impact of rubber products on the building occupants. In addition, the participants will understand the performance of rubber, from the impact of installation of the products, durability, maintenance requirements, and its end of use options.

How Taught: The CES facilitator utilizes a Power Point or slide presentation to provide an overview of how Rubber flooring can contribute to LEED and the low impact it has on the environment. The program will include with the dissemination of literature relevant to the presentation.
