Description: A presentation that explains the importance of specifying the surface that best suits the activity and conditions of play. By correctly specifying the best surface for the conditions the risk of injuries is greatly minimized.

Learning Objectives: The key lesson to be learned is that sport surfaces have very distinct performance characteristics that should be taken into account. Participants will learn that each activity has its own ideal coefficient of friction. They will learn the importance of specifying a sport surface meet the DIN and ASTM standards under ideal conditions. Participants will gain an understanding of what the different types of coefficient of friction are and what they measure. Lastly, participants will gain an understanding of key performance characteristics such as shock absorption, energy return, and vertical deflection, area of deflection, resiliency and consistency of response. They will understand how less than ideal coefficient of friction conditions can exist and can increase the chances of injury. Lastly, the presentation will go in detail of the potential surface related injuries that can occur and how to the right surface can reduce those types of injuries.

How Taught: The CES facilitator utilizes a Power Point or slide presentation to provide an overview of how by specifying the right sport surface can reduce the risk of sport related injuries. The program will include with the dissemination of literature relevant to the presentation.

A/V Needed: Electrical power and a screen for the Power Point or slide presentation. (The CES facilitator supplies the laptop and projectors.)

Target Audience: Architects, specifiers and other design professionals in the commercial market. The ideal audience size can be one on one or up to 50.
